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# WHITE TEA



Bai Mu Dan  
White Peony

 80°C

White Peony is a beautiful and delicate tea which undergoes very little processing. It is made from the unopened silvery buds and the top two leaves of the first flush, picked in spring. No heating or rolling is involved in production. Instead, the leaves are gently but skilfully withered to yield an easy-drinking white tea, full of soft fruit flavours and melon notes with a long, sweet aftertaste.



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# GREEN TEA



Dragons Well  
Long Jing

This delicious Dragon Well is grown in the hills of Zhejiang Province near Long Jing, the village where this famous tea originated. The green tea leaves are picked young and taken back to the village where the skilled tea masters use their bare hands to press them flat in a hot, dry wok in the traditional way. This arrests the oxidation process and ensures the liquor carries the notes of freshly cut grass, rounded off by a soft, nutty flavour.

Jade Tips  
Mao Jian

Mao Jian grows high in the cool, misty mountain air of Zhejiang. It has a clean, refreshing vegetal taste and a long lasting, pleasingly sweet aftertaste. This is a superb everyday, easy-drinking green tea.

Sencha

A Chinese sencha, the leaves of this tea are steamed directly after picking to stop oxidation. These verdant leaves give a bright green infusion that has light grassy notes with a slight trace of bitterness.



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# GREEN TEA



Genmaicha  
'Popcorn' tea

A tasty satisfying tea created by a glorious balance of fresh green tea and toasted rice. Originally created in Japan to make the tea leaves stretch a little further, Genmaicha is admired for its unique taste, green tea notes mingling with nutty rice, which is baked with the leaves.

Matcha

Shaded for a month before being picked, the leaves are hand processed, just like a superior green tea and are then stone-ground until ultra fine. Matcha powder is whisked with hot water for a velvety smooth, vivid green, and full bodied liquor with a creamy froth.



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# OOLONG TEA



Oriental Beauty

This rare and indulgent Taiwanese oolong is a tea like no other. It is produced in only the tiniest area of north western Taiwan, and possesses some unique characteristics due to its unusual processing style. The leaves aren't ready to be picked until they have been nibbled by a tiny insect called a 'jassid' during the summer months. This helps to develop a unique, fruity, honeyed flavour in the leaves, giving the tea rich, muscatel notes and an almost spicy aftertaste.

Big Red Robe

Da Hong Pao

Big Red Robe is one of the earliest oolongs ever produced and is made from leaves picked deep within the rocky Wuyi Mountains. This high grade oolong tea is handmade from tender leaves, withered, tumbled, curled and slow roasted in small batches over charcoal, to create an aromatic infusion with distinctive dark cocoa notes, a toasted, fruity flavour and a long smooth aftertaste.

Iron Buddha

Tie Guan Yin

With a lovely balance of fruit and floral flavours, Iron Buddha is the best known and most popular oolong tea in China. It is lightly roasted, making it a perfect introduction to this category of tea. With a rich and fruity aroma that develops through multiple infusions, this is a great everyday oolong tea.
